# Technical Bulletin RPS account upgrade to B6512





#### Issue

Using RPS or RPS-LITE version 6.03 to upgrade a B3512, B4512, or B5512, panel account to a B6512 account, the Log % Full parameter is corrupted in the upgraded account.



For B5512 accounts, all parameters in Point Assignments for points 17 and greater are set to their defaults in the upgraded account.



#### Resolution

This issue will be resolved in version 6.04 of RPS and RPS-LITE.

#### Workaround

To use RPS v6.03 to update a B3512, B4512, or B5512 account to a B6512 account follow the steps below:

First create a backup of the account in the Panel List:


- 1. Right-click the panel account you wish to upgrade. Select Export Selection.
- Import the backup account. Click File to open the file menu. Select Import. The import process asks you to rename the file. Append "\_backup" to the original file name.

Next, upgrade the original panel account to a B6512 account:

- 1. Right-click on the original panel account in the Panel List. Select Open Panel Data View.
- 2. Click Edit.
- 3. Click the Panel Type field. Select B6512.
- 4. Click OK.

Finally, edit the upgraded account to correct the Log % Full parameter. For accounts upgraded from a B5512 account, correct the parameters in Point Assignments for points 17 and greater.

Use the backup account as a reference.
