1.0 Issue

When a control panel programmed to report in Contact ID over PSTN has a Gas Trouble or Supervisory signal, the signal sent is received at the central station as a "308" (Panel Shutdown) instead of the expected "380" (Gas alarm).

2.0 Resolution

Bosch Security Systems, Inc. will resolve this issue for GV4 control panels with firmware version 2.03, with an expected released in April 2014, and for B Series control panels with the firmware version 2.02 expected to be released in February 2014.

Immediate Resolution

As these control panels do not currently use the "Panel Shutdown" report, you may choose to make changes to your automation software so that all reports are acted on appropriately.
